Keyworker meetings

Just a couple of reminders-

You do not need to bring in spare clothes for your child, we have plenty. We are spending a lot of time looking for bags which may or may not be around, so this enables us to change your child quicker. We also ask that you do not hang any bags on the coat trolley.





Please do not bring toys in from home, they get lost and children get upset.

You will need to apply sun lotion to your child before they come to pre-school as we are not able to do this for you. Don't forget your sunhats if the weather is hot although we do try to provide as much shade as possible.
