Dates for this term

All of our new friends settled in so well last term and are having great fun with us. We are all so proud of you!!

Lunches

If your child is staying for lunch, we ask that you provide a healthy lunch with no sweets in a lunch box and not a lunch bag. We cannot fit lunch bags on the trolley or in the fridge and they can get very dirty and collect germs.

Could we also ask that grapes and tomatoes are cut in half as they are a choking hazard and no nuts or peanut butter as we have children with allergies.

If your child has a yoghurt in a pot please provide a spoon.

Tuesdays

On Tuesdays, can you please bring your buggies into the hall for storage and please fold them up. We will be using the hall a lot more this term and they do take up a lot of space if left up. Tuesdays 6th and 13th December – we ask that you collect your child from our playground entrance - up the path to where our lovely mural is and come through the gate.

Water bottles

We have found that last term the children were not using their water from the bottles but were asking for milk and water from our cups, so we are asking for you not to bring the bottles in. We also ask that you don't bring in a drink for lunch either as we do have plenty of milk and water for all – thank you for your understanding.





Unwell children

If your child is feeling unwell, give us a call and please do not bring them in to Playwell. Please keep them at home until they are feeling better. Covid is still around and we need to protect our Playwell community – children, staff and parents – thank you.

We must advise you that we cannot give calpol to your child.

Energy saving

We are all currently watching our energy usage at the moment so, with this in mind, we are asking you to bring an extra layer in for our child in case they feel a bit chilly. We hope that you won't notice any change and we will try to keep your children as warm as we possibly can.

Photographer

The photographer will be visiting us on Friday 18th November during the morning session. If your child does not attend Friday morning, you are welcome to bring them in to have their photograph taken, please let us know if you will be doing this. Siblings are welcome too.

This is a great fundraiser for Playwell and we thank you for your support.

Arriving for morning session

Our session times are 9-12 and 9-3. We ask that you arrive before 9.15 when we close the doors so that the children get into good timekeeping for school. Their names are out when they come in and this is important for them to start recognising their name in preparation for writing it before they go to school. They can then join in with play with their friends. If they arrive late, they do miss out on these important parts of the day and we do have to leave the children to come and answer the door. If you know that you are going to be later than 9.30 we will ask you to miss the morning session and come in at 12. If you would like to discuss this further, please come and speak to us.

Last term we had our harvest collection and you were all so generous – thank you. We also had a lovely walk to deliver our collection to the Philipot Almshouses and they were greatly received. Thank you to Arina, Sue, Rebecca and Barbara for coming with us, we couldn't have gone without you.
